## CHECKLIST FOR K3 VISA

### DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR APPLYING K3 VISA AT THE AMERICAN CONSULATE:

1. Valid Indian Passport for travel to the U.S. with a validity of at least six months beyond the applicant's intended period of stay in the United States.
2. Two duly filled DS-156 & DS-157 forms.
3. Visa application fee of Rs. 4,600/- in respect of American Consulate to be deposited in one of the designated branches of HDFC Bank or DD favoring "US Embassy – Visa Fees" for the same amount.
4. Service fee of Rs. 276/- in respect of VFS to be deposited in one of the designated branches of HDFC Bank or DD favoring "HDFC Bank a/c VFS" for the same amount.
5. Two duly filled DS-3052 Supplemental Application forms.
6. One DS-156K, Non-immigrant Fiancé(e) Visa Application form.
7. Two photographs of the visa applicant measuring 50 X 50 mm, showing full face with light background.
8. **Police Certificate:** Police certification from all the places the applicant has lived since the age of 16 years. One certificate must be obtained from the applicant's local station and one certificate from the applicant's regional passport office.

Applicants are also required to submit police certificates from the police authorities in each country other than India and the U.S. in which he or she has resided for at least six months after the age of 16. A police certificate must also be obtained from the police authorities of any place where the applicant has been arrested for any reason, regardless of how long he or she lived there. Police certificates from certain countries are considered unobtainable.

9. **Court and Prison records:** If the applicant has been convicted of a crime, then s/he must obtain a certified copy of each court record and of any prison record, regardless of the fact that they may have subsequently benefited from an amnesty, pardon or other act of clemency.
10. Copy of the applicant's official Birth Certificate.
11. **Proof of Relationship with US citizen spouse:** Wedding invitations, church certificates, wedding photographs or other reliable documents that show the required relationship. For proof of an ongoing relationship, please submit such evidence as cards, letters, emails, photographs, phone records and other evidence to establish the applicant's relationship is continual.

12. **Proof of Relationship of any child (K4):** Birth Certificate issued by the Registrar of Births & Deaths, birth registrations issued within one year of the birth, Secondary school leaving certificates, old ration cards, old baptismal certificates, college degree certificates, mark sheets, family photos or other reliable documents which show the required relationship.
13. **Evidence of Legal Termination of any previous marriage:** Copies of any divorce decrees, death certificates, or annulment decrees if either the US citizen or spouse has been previously married.
14. **Medical Examination:** The applicant must obtain a medical certificate from one of the physician or hospital approved by the US Consulates in India.
15. **Evidence of Support:** The applicant must show evidence that s/he will not become a public charge in the United States. For this purpose, a completed I-134 Affidavit of Support form along with supporting documents from your sponsor is essential to prove that your sponsor has sufficient financial.
16. **Courier Fees:** DD for Rs. 350/- payable to "Blue Dart Express Limited" towards the courier delivery charges. An additional fee of Rs. 50 is payable for every additional passport.
